

LUDOTHÈQUE NYON RÉGION - REGULATIONS

MEMBERSHIP

There are three types of annual memberships, per family.

The membership is valid as of the day of enrolment and each time it is renewed. The member can ask for a card, if needed. Special conditions are granted to grandparents who wish to rent games occasionally, to registered child-minders (Nyon) as well as childhood professionals (crèches, UAPE, speech therapists, etc.). Any other specific request has to be approved by the committee.

The games of the "giant games" group are excluded from the memberships.

LOANS

The number of games that can be borrowed is defined by the type of membership. The games can be chosen in any group (except for the giant games). Please note that only the group Playmobil is limited to one game per child. Exceptions are granted for festivities and birthday parties.

A rental fee, mentioned on each game, is charged per four-week loan, for the "Basic" membership. The member can renew the loan once for another 4 weeks; renewals can be requested by telephone or e-mail. The second loan will have to be paid on returning the game (for the "Basic" membership).

LATE RETURNS / REMINDERS

Games that are not returned on the date due will be subject, as of the next day, to a fine of CHF 1.- per game per week. Reminders will be sent by e-mail.

After the third reminder, the member will be charged the cost of the games, the fines, and a charge for the replacement of the game.

DEPOSIT / COMPENSATION

Before leaving the library, borrowers are expected to check that the items borrowed are complete and in good condition, with the help of staff if necessary. Games are expected to be returned in the same condition. If there's anything wrong, the Ludothèque must be contacted the same day. Please do not attempt to repair anything yourself.

If games are returned with parts missing, the user will be notified by email and have a month to return the missing parts. If the parts are not returned, a fee will be charged (see rates posted at the library).

An appropriate compensation, including for the cases/plastic boxes, will be charged in case of damage to the games (other than normal wear and tear) or if a missing part cannot be replaced, rendering the game unfit for use.

USE OF THE PREMISES

In the "Collection" room, please do not open any game boxes. For safety reasons, the use of toys and vehicles is reserved for rental only. However, you may test the vehicles for size and functioning before renting. Games and toys are at your disposal in the "découvertes" room to play with your child. Please make sure to keep the room clean and tidy, so that the place remains pleasant and welcoming for everyone.

The purpose of these premises is for on-the-spot playing. Eating is not permitted, and you are requested not to use mobile phones, tablets or any other electronic device.

RESPONSIBILITY

While they are in the library, parents or carers are responsible for the children.

Parents are responsible for the games rented by the family.

The games library accepts no responsibility for any damage incurred while using the games rented.

The games library committee reserves the right to ban anyone who does not follow the above regulations.
